
Where food was scarce, destruction near, Bombs falling, hearts filled with fear.

> As daylight kissed the silent ground, Isam and Baasima were bound. Hand in hand, they stealthily fled, With courage, hope, and dreams ahead.


Along the path, they met three beasts, Guarding borders, night's fierce quests. But fate smiled upon their way, With messengers who led the day.
